

# COUPLING NETWORK

## CDN 5-64

The Coupling Network CDN 5-64 allows superimposition of surge impulse voltages with waveform 10/700  $\mu$ s to ISDN-Ports.

The Coupling Network has 64 outputs with two lines each. The test pulse can be coupled to one of the 64 output ports.

The plug-in coupling impedance board can be fitted with user specific coupling impedances, such as capacitors, varistors, transil diodes etc.

The desired coupling path is set by remote control signals, which are transferred from a PC by use of an optically isolated interface. The selected coupling path is displayed on the front panel.
